## WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE A BEAR?

If you have below a 3.0 GPA, we'll also take test scores, community involvement, leadership and other experience into account. Either way, we ask you to submit test scores for advising, scholarship decisions and other purposes.

Note: Students cannot qualify for in-state residency after attending UNC as a WUE student. One would need to decline WUE and pay nonresident tuition for one year before establishing in-state residency.
${ }^{2}$ This is what students pay after the College Opportunity Fund (COF) is applied to their bill, $\$ 85$ per RI credit. To be eligible for COF rates, Colorado resident students should apply at CollegelnColorado.org.
